8:30 – 3:00 pm

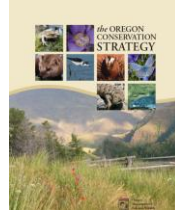
Objectives:

- Learn about pollination and its importance, including host and nectar plants
- Learn about pollinator conservation by touring projects that protect or enhance their habitat
- Learn about and discuss actions that benefit pollinators – bees, butterflies, beetles, and birds

- Natural resources professionals – including land trusts, agencies and restorationists – who make decisions that could impact pollinator habitat

Workshop format: We will meet in Albany (at the Weyerhaeuser office at 2730 Pacific Boulevard SE, near I-5) for a brief orientation, then spend the day touring pollinator field projects (including Fender's blue butterfly, bees, beetles and beetle banking, and more!) in the mid-Willamette Valley with experts, have lunch at Gathering Together Farm and conclude with a wrap-up discussion back at the Weyerhaeuser office.
